

Hampstead Hill School Remote education provision:

- **Remote curriculum**

We teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school wherever possible and appropriate. However, we have needed to make some adaptations in some subjects. For example, (our Science lessons will be conducted every 2 weeks and Philosophy for children will be postponed until further notice. We will focus mainly on the core subjects such as Numeracy, Literacy and Phonics)

- **Remote teaching and study time each day**

Each Reception class has been divided into 2 groups (Group 1 and Group 2)

We are providing 4 interactive sessions a day for each group, 30 min long – Numeracy, literacy and Phonics sessions, and 10 min long register time session. There is also Interactive story time on Monday and Friday for the whole class and pre-recorded Topic, Music PE and Yoga sessions accessible via Google Classroom. There will be individual interactive reading sessions with Celia once a week (15 min long). We will be providing commercially available websites and links supporting the teaching (Topmarks, Letters and sounds) which could be used in between the live sessions. We are providing 2 hours of interactive teaching per day as well as pre-recorded Topic lessons and time between the session to complete written assignments. Each day will start at 8.50 and finish at 2.30-3.00 o'clock. Weekly timetable has been sent to all parents.

- **Accessing remote education**

We are using Teams and Google Classroom for delivery of lessons and for the work assessment. We are sending electronically weekly homework packs every Friday to correspond with the online sessions and for independent work. We are also sending optional activities packs. Homework Packs can be printed at school if needed.

- **Engagement and feedback**

Children's completed work will be sent to class teachers via Google Classroom

Teachers will mark and return work to pupils via the comments feature on GC within 24 hours. Children will be given verbal feedback at the end of each session. Parents should ensure that quiet place is provided during interactive sessions, and children have no other distractions such as toys, TV, food or siblings around them. We also ask parents to adhere to session times. Parents will be contacted immediately in case when their children miss daily sessions without prior explanation. Parents are welcome to contact their class teachers via email every day after 3 pm, we are aiming to answer each query the same day. We also ask parents not to use rubbers to correct children work.

- **Additional support**

We will provide differentiated work for children who need additional support. We will liaise with school Sendco to ensure appropriate education is provided.
